


Setting / changing TCP/IP device settings

Before installing, changing the device parameters, make the following network settings.

Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4) - double click.










- Use the following DNS server addresses (just mark)




Use the connection interface depending on the type of reader.

Configuring a TCP / IP device

If you configure the IP address and port, the reader must be connected to the computer through the router only







At the end of all settings, click **Apply**!
